Whether you're a seasoned Fringe fan or a first-time visitor, this year promises more than ever—3,352 shows across 265 venues, featuring international artists from 58 countries

1. A dizzying variety of genres

Expect everything from stand up comedy (nearly 40% of the lineup) and provocative theatre to dance, circus, children's shows, cabaret, spoken word and much more.

2. Comedy excellence

The Fringe features all 17 Edinburgh Comedy Award winners returning with new programmes, including stars like Tim Key and Jordan Brookes. Don't miss Urooj Ashfaq ("How To Be A Baddie") or Daniel Sloss in work in progress shows—a chance to see the next big thing in intimate settings

3. Homegrown and global talent

The "Made in Scotland" showcase—back with funding from the Scottish Government's EXPO Fund—brings together dance, theatre, music and daring new voices from across Scotland. Meanwhile, artists from around the world showcase cutting edge, topical work in Fringe's open access spirit.

4. Unique fringe gems

Look out for magical solo performances like Ben Hart's theatre magic shows, cult pop parodies such as "Buffy Revamped", and sketch-duos like The Pin

On-the-day bargain hunters can snag deals at the Half? Price Hut near Mound Precinct.

Consider staying near central hubs-Royal Mile, Grassmarket, Old Town-for easy access to venues.

Tip: Many shows preview before August 1, so check listings in late July

Beyond the Stage

Street theatre & buskers: over 500 performers enliven the Royal Mile and city squares with magic, comedy, music and impersonations—all free and street-level interactive.

Cafés, pop-up bars, food stalls and art installations transform Edinburgh into a vibrant party zone.

Venues range from historic theatres like Gilded Balloon and Pleasance to unusual spaces like Summerhall's repurposed veterinary
